Terms of Reference

approved by the Board of Directors 2009.06.24

The Board Communications Committee shall be appointed by the TI Board of Directors and shall have at least four members, including the TI-S Director of Communications serving in an ex-officio capacity, and at least two members of the TI Board. The Committee's chairman should be a member of the TI Board. At least one member of the Committee should not be a member of the TI Board of Directors, but a member of either a national chapter or an individual member, appointed for a renewable one-year term.

The Communications Committee will:

- a. Advise the Board on strategies consistent with effective internal and external communication.
- b. Assist the TI-S Director of Communications when requested to do so.
- c. Report to the Annual Membership Meeting and to the TI Board on progress towards agreed movement-wide communications goals and objectives.
